

Instructions on IEEE Conference Paper and Digest Formats

1. All papers must be prepared strictly following the paper template in IEEE Xplore compliant PDF format.
2. IEEE Conference paper is typically limited to six (6) pages in the standard IEEE conference double-column format. IEEE conference two-column format margin settings are as follows:
 - Paper Size: Letter size, (8.5x11.0) in or (21.59x27.94) cm
 - Top margin: 0.75in or 1.9cm
 - Bottom margin: 1.0in or 2.54cm
 - Left margin: 0.625in or 1.59cm
 - Right margin: 0.625in or 1.59cm
 - Text width: 7.25in or 18.41cm
 - Text height: 9.25in or 23.5cm
 - Column width: 3.5in or 8.89cm
 - Column gap: 0.25in or 0.635cm

IEEE conference two-column format font size settings:

- Font recommendation: Times New Roman or Arial
- Title: 22pt
- Author List: 11pt
- Section Titles: 10pt
- Regular Text: 10pt
- Table/Figure captions: 8pt
- Sub-scripts: 8pt
- Sub-Sub-scripts: 7pt
- Footnotes: 8pt

The papers should **not** contain page numbers, header, or footer. English paper templates in Word, PDF, and LaTeX are available for download from the conference website. Please follow the paper template strictly.

3. Please make sure that all the fonts used in text/figures/pictures/tables/equations of your paper PDF file are properly embedded and subsetted.
4. Every accepted paper final submission must be accompanied by a single-page Digest PPT file to be used in the conference Program Digest Book. Please download the Digest PPT template from conference website and follow the template strictly when preparing your paper Digest PPT file.
5. By accepting your final paper submission to IEEE conference, we assume that the research work reported in your submitted paper is original and the authors of the paper own all the intellectual properties of all the contents of your paper. It is the responsibility of the authors to make sure that all the IEEE copyright regulations are strictly followed and responsibilities are duly observed.
